Smart Tuition: Smart Tuition is a company used to manage monthly payments. A \$41 processing fee is added to the first tuition payment. Families sign up for monthly payments at the time they sign their admission contract.

Other Fees:

Scrip: Each family is responsible for generating a profit of \$250 by purchasing gift cards. This fee can be added to the total cost of tuition if the family decides to opt out of the Scrip program. See the scrip handout for further information.

Parent Service Hours: Each family is required to do 10 parent service hours on campus or through school fundraisers. A family can opt out of this requirement by adding \$200 to the total cost of tuition.

Thrift Store Hours: Each OMS family is required to volunteer 15 hours at Mission Thrift (Families with their oldest child at Nativity are required to volunteer 10 hours). A family can opt of out this option by adding \$300 (\$200 for Nativity) to the total cost of tuition.

Tuition Assistance

In order to receive tuition assistance, the student(s) must be offered admission to Old Mission School/Nativity. Registration must be paid in full and a tuition assistance packet (available online or in the OMS office) must be filled out and submitted. Private School Aid then reviews all applications and provides OMS with an assessment. A tuition assistance meeting occurs in June and the families are notified about their financial aid.
